While GAS is the most common bacterial cause of pharyngitis, acute pharyngitis is most commonly caused by viruses. 1 GAS is the causative organism in 20-30% of cases of pharyngitis, but can increase to 35-50% depending on the population and season. 2,3 Notably, the symptoms of viral and bacterial pharyngitis can be challenging to differentiate.

### Diagnosis and Treatment of Streptococcal Pharyngitis ...

Fungal: Some cases of pharyngitis are caused by the fungal infection such as Candida albicans causing oral thrush. Non-infectious: Pharyngitis may also be caused by mechanical, chemical or thermal irritation, for example, cold air or acid reflux. Some medications may produce pharyngitis such as pramipexole and antipsychotics.
