Book titles appear in italics. Edition. Include details of the edition in brackets after the title, followed by a full-stop. Editions should only be noted if 2nd ed. or above, if a special 1st edition (e.g. 1st Aust. ed.), or if the book has been otherwise updated or revised (e.g. Rev. ed., Updated 8th ed., etc).

Electronic Books. Don't include the place of publication or a publisher for an electronic book (ebook). Instead follow the rules below: Ebooks from Websites (not from library databases) If an ebook from a website was originally published in print, give the author, year, title, edition (if given) and the url.

To cite a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the book: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

Book chapters - APA (6th Edition) Referencing Guide ...

Entire books and individual chapters are sometimes assigned their own unique digital object identifiers (DOIs). If the book or chapter you are citing lists a DOI, include it at the end of your reference in place of the publisher information, without a period. Cite the edition of the book you used.
