Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns). An APA format citation is an APA format in-text citation. These are found within your paper, anytime a quote or paraphrase is included. They usually only include the name of the author and the date the source was published. Here's an example of one: Hypertrophic cardiomyopathy is even discussed in the book, *The Emperor of Any Place*.

The APA citation style is a parenthetical author-date style, meaning that you need to put the author's last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.
