Adult Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder is very prevalent in our society. An estimated 4.7% or 9 million adults in the US have ADHD. Of that 9 million, only about 15 % have been diagnosed and treated, only 1 in 4 of all adults with ADHD was diagnosed in childhood—and even fewer are treated.
