It cannot be emphasized enough: Bridge is a partnership game. Together, you and your partner are trying to determine if you have a fit in a suit or whether you should be in a NT contract. You are also trying to calculate how many points your partnership has (based on HCP and distribution), so you can gauge how high to bid and when to stop bidding.

Bridge - Step 1 for Beginners : A Teacher First - Learn to ...

The basic design (see diagrams) has the two logs laid on a flat rock or a log sill at each end. Boards are nailed across the logs (if you are using 7-foot boards, a third log in the middle may be necessary). Approach ramps can be made out of a few short boards or the gap can be filled in with rocks. Pin the bridge in place with stakes.

How to Learn the Basics of Bridge - YouTube

Simple classic Goren bidding with 5-card majors, 1NT 16-18, strong twos, Stayman, Blackwood, Gerber. Evaluating your hand: High-card points (HCP): A=4, K=3, Q=2, J=1 Long-suit points: Add 1 point for a good 5-card suit, 2 for a 6-card suit, 3 for a 7-card suit. Short-suit points: If you have a trump fit with partner, add 1 point for a doubleton in a side suit, 2 for a singleton, 3 for a void.
