The term "behavioral health" is used to emphasize the broad applicability of integrated health services in medical care. Behavioral health encompasses behavioral factors in chronic illness care, care of physical symptoms associated with stress rather than diseases, and health behaviors, as well as mental health and substance abuse conditions and diagnoses.

Health-promoting behaviors are among the main determinants of health that have been recognized as underlying factors in disease prevention [1]. Modifying lifestyle factors could potentially prevent many cases of heart disease and types 2 diabetes [2]. Thus, health-promoting behaviors and a healthy lifestyle should be considered as major strategies to improve and maintain health [3].

The major reason cited regarding preference in studies that applied the HBM to disease outbreak preparedness, was the HBM's history empirically predicting preventive health behavior 14, 15, 16, 18. However, it was integrated with other models or theories in three studies 16, 17, 18.

Why the Integration of Behavioral and Physical Health Care is Needed Behavioral health disorders, such as depression and substance use, often co-occur with other common chronic diseases such as diabetes and heart disease, and chronic physical diseases are frequently encountered in persons with more serious mental disorders such as schizophrenia

Behavioral Health Integration

In this age of accountability, and irrespective of whether they work in health-care settings or conventional mental health settings, all therapists will be increasingly expected to provide effective psychosocial treatment to individuals and families who face co-morbid medical conditions.

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
