Capitation in California: A Study of Physician ...

Capitation rates are developed using local costs and average utilization of services and therefore can vary from one region of the country to another. In many plans, a risk pool is established as a percentage of the capitation payment. Money in this risk pool is withheld from the physician until the end of the fiscal year.

A pilot program in California reported that capitated funding provided service flexibility and shifted services towards rehabilitation; this study did not examine whether there were cost savings (Chandler, Hu, Meisel, et al. 1997).

A 2009 review of studies reported that capitation was most cost-effective in groups with moderate health care needs, with practices reporting fewer illnesses and more enrollments than fee-for-service practices.

Sub-capitation is particularly prevalent among health plans in California—the only study state where plan representatives said that the majority of providers are reimbursed this way—but is less common in other states.
