Mississippi River Bridge: Engineering Accident Case Study

On the morning of June 28, 1983, at around 1:30 a.m., an eastbound section of the bridge fell into the chilly waters of the river, leaving three people dead and others injured. Each bridge span was 30 m (100 ft) long, three travel lanes wide, with a 53 skew.

Mianus River Bridge | Failure Case Studies

The 10 km section between the Sadi Bridge on the Diyarbakir-Silvan highway and the historical Ten-Eyed Bridge (Dicle Bridge) was considered as a study area. The Tigris River, which flows in a wide valley with a low slope, is characterized by lowland streams, so there are settlements along the river and fertile farmland (Figure 3).

Category: Launched Bridges, Case Studies - Published by: Raphael Gagné. Built in the scope of the Highway 73 extension project in the Beauce region, the Gilbert River Bridge is a 1,070-ft. (326-meter) structure that was erected 170 feet (52 meters) over the Gilbert River and 34 th Street in Notre-Dame-des-Pins, Quebec. The new bridge features eight lines of 11 girders, with each component measuring 11 feet (3.4 meters) tall and weighing up to 48 tons apiece.

Case Study: Gilbert River Bridge - Canam - Bridges

On the 28th of June 1983 at 1.30am, a 30m section of the eastbound span collapsed and fell 21m into the River Mianus. The section collapsed as two tractor-trailers and two automobiles crossed the span. Three people were killed and a further three were seriously injured.

Eyewitness reports suggested that a span at the south end collapsed first and that the failure propagated across the bridge to the other two spans in turn. Much of the wreckage remained above the water, but about 50 vehicles with their occupants went into the river. At the time, repairs were being made to the bridge deck, guardrails, and lights.
