For transactions that occurred prior to 1 January 2011, the previous national, State and Territory consumer laws continue to apply. The ACL is administered by the ACCC and state and territory consumer protection agencies and is enforced by all Australian courts and tribunals, including the courts and tribunals of the States and Territories.
