### 7 Core Competencies Shape Career Readiness for College ...

Competency: A general statement that describes the desired knowledge, skills, and behaviors of a student graduating from a program (or completing a course). Competencies commonly define the applied skills and knowledge that enable people to successfully perform in professional, educational, and other life contexts.

In 2017, the NLN issued core competencies for graduate programs that prepare nurse educators for academic positions. The concepts are based on four broad program outcomes: human flourishing, sound nursing judgment, professional identity and the spirit of inquiry.

A companion toolkit was compiled to provide resources for the implementation of the competencies. A 1-day conference was held in California to launch the cultural competencies and toolkit. Dissemination to graduate nursing programs is in process, with emphasis on faculty readiness to undertake this graduate educational transformation.
