Environmental Impact Assessment. Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is the process of examining the anticipated environmental effects of a proposed project - from consideration of environmental aspects at design stage, through consultation and preparation of an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR), evaluation of the EIAR by a competent authority, the subsequent decision as to whether the project should be permitted to proceed, encompassing public response to that decision.

### Environmental Impact Assessment :: Environmental ...

I.Purpose. The purpose of this procedure is to provide guidance for evaluating the environmental aspects and impacts of the organization's activities, services, and products. The evaluation should result in a determination of whether or not a particular aspect has any significant environmental impacts and if so, whether or not the organization can control or influence those impacts.

### EMS Procedure: Environmental Aspect and Impact Evaluation

The organization identifies and evaluates the actual or potential aspects and impacts to the environment, whether adverse or beneficial, from its activities, services and facilities. During the evaluation process, significant impacts to the environment are determined. Definitions.

### Activities, Environmental Impacts & Aspects

Environmental aspects, impacts and risk assessment. The identification of significant construction activities and potential hazards/ impacts that could eventuate during the construction of the Project is central to the selection of appropriate environmental mitigation measures. Environmental impact assessments commenced in the 1960s, as part of increasing environmental awareness. EIAs involved a technical evaluation intended to contribute to more objective decision making. In the United States, environmental impact assessments obtained formal status in 1969, with enactment of the National Environmental Policy Act. EIAs have been used increasingly around the world.

### Evaluation of Environmental Aspects

Environmental aspects: An element of an organisation's activities, products or services that can interact with the environment. Environmental impacts: An environmental impact is the outcome of that interaction of an organisation's activities with the environment i.e what impact did it actually have. The next section of the register is for prioritising the risk and impacts of all of the environmental aspects of a particular job or project by assessing:

### Environmental Aspects and Impacts Register (Easily ...

The assessment of the severity of an environmental impact drives management attention and supports planning for mitigation. A qualitative risk assessment scheme consisting of qualitative probability and impact scales should be undertaken to ensure detailed understanding of the effects of each impact.

### 6.1.2 Environmental Aspects and Impacts

Identifying and developing a significant environmental aspects and impacts register is key to ensure the effectiveness of the Environmental Management Systems based on the ISO 14001 standard. The environmental aspects are all the elements, activities, processes and products/services of an organisation that can interact and has an impact on the environment.

### Developing an Environmental Aspects and Impacts Register ...

An Environmental Impact Assessment is more likely to be required if the project affects the features for which the sensitive area was designated.

### Environmental Impact Assessment - GOV.UK

To establish, implement & maintain a procedure for identification of environmental aspects of activities, products, and services covered under the scope of EHS Management system and to evaluate the environmental aspects and further determine significant impacts on the environment.

### Procedure for Identification and Evaluation of ...

An environmental impact assessment is performed, as its name suggests, in order to identify and evaluate the potential impacts upon the environment at the decision making stage before work commences or operations are altered. By conducting the impact assessment at the outset, potential problems can be considered and changes can be made to mitigate them before a lot of time and money has been spent and wasted getting to that point.
