4 Essential Guitar Chord Progressions for Beginners

Place your first finger on the 5 th fret on the 5 th string. Then Place your 3 rd finger across strings 4, 3, 2, and bar those strings.. When play this form of the chord you don’t want to play the 6th string. Pro Tip – Use the tip of your first finger to gently press it against the 6th string. This way when strumming, if you accidentally strike the 6th string.
