What does the Bible say about forgiving others? How can I ...

1. Forgiveness is not tolerating. God takes sin seriously. Ultimately He is the one who will avenge us and justify all that was wronged. Forgiving our trespassers does not mean we simply tolerate things. Instead, we keep ourselves pure by trusting God to be our avenger (Proverbs 20:22). 2. Forgiveness is not the absence of anger.

Trust and forgiveness are processes of healing. Forgiveness (releasing from punishment and entrusting it to God) is the choice Christians are called to make right away, however healing from the hurt takes time. Trust, on the other hand, is a process of rebuilding security and assurance through the demonstration of new patterns.

Christians should trust that God will deliver justice to those who have wronged them, Warren adds. So it's important for believers to practice forgiveness for their own spiritual health. "Forgiveness is only your part, whether they respond or not, whether they ask for it or not, whether they even recognize they need it or not.

Proverbs 3:5-6 says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." Forgiveness is a commitment to a personalized process of change. To move from suffering to forgiveness, you might: Recognize the value of forgiveness and how it can improve your life; Identify what needs healing and who needs to be forgiven and for what; Consider joining a support group or seeing a counselor

Forgiving yourself is not specifically addressed in the Bible, but there are principles regarding forgiveness that should be applied. For example, when God forgives us, it states that He remembers our sins no more (Jeremiah 31:34).

Forgiving Yourself - God

Forgetting about the offense and trusting time to take care of it. Asking God to forgive the person who hurt you. Asking God to forgive you for being angry or resentful against the person who offended you. Denying that you were really hurt; after all, there are others who have suffered more.

Trust involves a turning back to God, a real conversion of our whole lives to God, repenting of our sins and forgiving others. Trust is a living faith. Trust means that we agree to let God be God, instead of trying to be God ourselves. (Trust is the antidote to the first sin of Adam!)

While God commands us to forgive others, he never told us to keep trusting those who violated our trust or even to like being around those who hurt us. The first step to understanding forgiveness is learning what it is and isn't.

God Calls You to Forgive In the meantime, God calls the innocent spouse to forgive. He knows the spouse is not going to feel like forgiving, but our forgiving another is based on God's forgiveness of us (Matthew 6:12, 14). God does not wait for us to be trustworthy before He forgives us.

God calls us to humility and repentance in order to receive His healing, and now is the perfect time in history for all people to cry out to Him for salvation. If we ask for His forgiveness through Jesus Christ, He will grant it. If we ask for His shelter, He will provide it. Psalm 91 also makes that clear.
