The 2007 NAEPP guidelines [] and the 2009 VA/DoD asthma management guidelines [] use the severity of asthma classification below, with features of asthma severity divided into three charts to reflect classification in different age groups (0-4 y, 5-11 y, and 12 y and older). Asthma Guidelines: Guidelines Summary, Classification ...

The first international guidelines were formulated by the USA National Heart Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI) in 1991. 5 and this expert panel report was updated and reviewed several times and finally published in 2008 as an Expert Panel Report 3 (EPR-3). 6 However, the first evidence based guidelines for asthma were published under GINA in 1995 and were revised in 2006.
