Abstract Reasoning is the fourth subtest in UCAT. It assesses your non-verbal and visuo-spatial reasoning ability. You will be required to identify patterns, spot trends, engage in hypothesis testing and ignore distracting information in order to arrive at the right answer.

What Is an Abstract Reasoning Test? An abstract reasoning test evaluates your inductive logic. That is to say, your ability to recognize patterns, analyze data, and form connections. Linked directly to basic, fluid intelligence, your capacity for abstract reasoning has nothing to do with your education or your mother tongue.

The abstract reasoning test is timed and, although different tests may have different time limits, you should typically expect to be given approximately 25- 30 seconds per question. The abstract reasoning test is designed so only 1% to 5% of test-takers can correctly answer all questions within the time limit, with the most difficult questions placed typically at the end of the test.

What to expect in your abstract aptitude test or abstract ...

Abstract reasoning test questions usually feature a series of patterns or shapes that are all related. Start each question by taking inventory of the building blocks of the pattern. Look for predictable changes from 1 image to the next and keep an eye out for details like the number and size of the shapes, the number of sides that each shape has, and the shading and orientation of each shape.
