Earl had developed a syncopated three-finger picking style using his thumb, index, and middle fingers that we now know as bluegrass.

Scruggs-style banjo is a roll-based approach where you use a different right-hand finger (either the thumb, index, or middle finger) consecutively for each eighth note you strike. Most of the time, you also move to a different string with each note you play.
