Mozart's Piano Sonata No. 14 in C Minor, K. 457 follows this standard practice as the first movement is in single movement form, the second movement is a drawn out ABA, and the last movement resembles a rondo. Completed on October 14, 1784, this piece was composed during Mozart's Vienna years.

Composed in Vienna in the fall of 1784, the C minor sonata was entered in the thematic catalog Mozart started earlier that year on October 14. For Mozart, 1784 was a year of intense compositional activity for the piano, the eight preceding entries in the catalog all indicating piano works.

Mozart Analysis - Piano Sonata in C (Sonata Facile), K ...

Bars 5-8: Bridge-passage or Transition. In Bar 6 the transition modulates to G major (the dominant), in which key it ends on a half-cadence, Bar 8. Bars 9-14: Second Subject in G major (Dominant). The special point to notice in this subject is in the responsive phrase (Bars 11-14) and arises from the fact that the movement is barred, as above mentioned, in 4/4 time, instead of 2/4 time.

Analysis: Mozart Piano Sonata in B-Flat Major K. 570 No. 1 Mozart's Piano Sonata in Bb K.570 was written in Vienna in the February of 1789 and first published posthumously in 1796. A violin part was included, however it was "so lacking in invention that it can be considered spurious with near certainty" (Robins, 2014).

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, 1756-179 String Quartet in G Major, K. 387, No. 1 of the "Haydn" Quartets, 1782. After moving to Vienna, acquiring a deeper education in Bach, meeting Haydn for the first time and encountering his landmark string quartets, Op. 33, published only a year before in 1781, a twenty-six-year-old Mozart turned again to the genre of string quartet.
