Origin and development of health cooperation. International health cooperation began with the first International Sanitary Conference in Paris, which opened on 23 July 1851. The objective of this conference was to harmonize and reduce to a safe minimum the conflicting and costly maritime quarantine requirements of different European nations.

Established in Paris in 1908, the International Health Office collected and distributed information from various health departments around the world, though it had no authority to act on its own. In 1922, and in accordance with Article 23 of the Covenant (concerning the prevention and control of disease), the League of Nations Health Committee and Health Section were established.

HoNOS (Health of the Nation Outcomes Scales) was developed during the early 90s by the Royal College of Psychiatrists as a measure of the health and social functioning of people with severe mental illness. The scales contain 12 items measuring behaviour, impairment, symptoms and social functioning.
