The basic theory behind the concept of a learning curve is that there will usually be an initial period in which the amount invested will be greater than the return, but after the learning curve has been overcome, the return should be greater than the investment.

A is the time it took to complete the task the first time. X is the total number of attempts or units of output. B represents the slope of the function.

A learning curve is a graphical representation of the relationship between how proficient someone is at a task and the amount of experience they have. Proficiency (measured on the vertical axis) usually increases with increased experience (the horizontal axis), that is to say, the more someone performs a task, the better they get at it.
