The Eternal Priest-King. "The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, 'You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek'" (v. 4). - Psalm 110:4-7. Appearing on the scene almost out of nowhere to bless Abraham and then disappearing almost as soon as he arrived, Melchizedek is one of the more enigmatic figures recorded in Scripture (Gen. 14:17-20).

The king as priest and seer. Religious duties quite often are connected with the office of chieftain, who is also priest or seer and rainmaker—all in one. Correspondingly, in nontribal societies, cultic functions belong to the office of the king. In the 3rd dynasty of Uruk, Lugalzaggisi is described as king of the country, priest of the god Anu (the god of the heavens), and prophet of Nisaba (goddess of grasses and writing).

In Israel it was a strict law that kings should not be priests, and priests should not be king. But Ahaz was so bold in his rebellion that he served as a priest at the altar of his own design.
